# Responsibilities

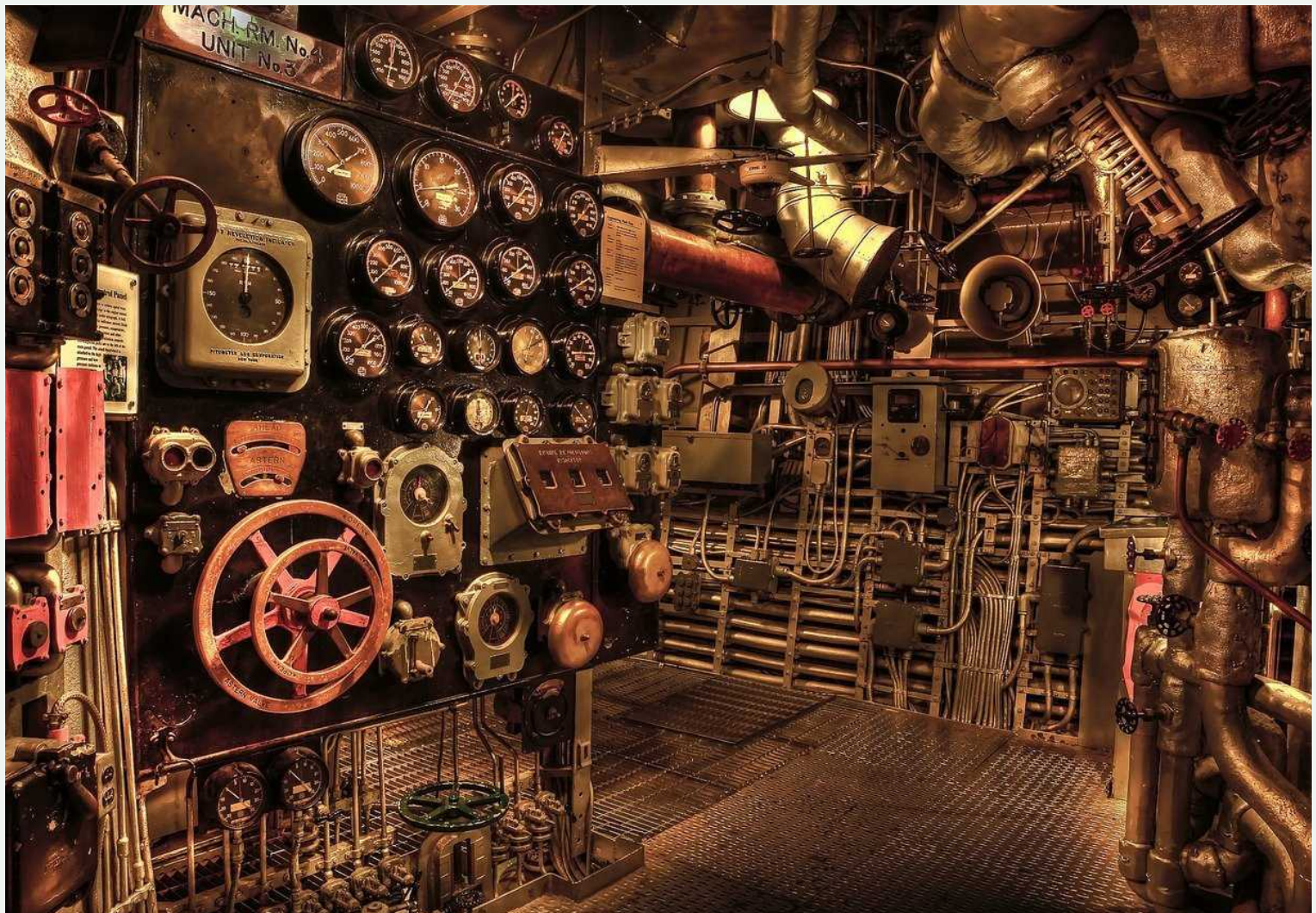
Working closely with the sales team, you will contribute to the scoping out of new projects, ensuring they can be delivered in line with client expectations.
