As a Senior DevOps Engineer you will join a multinational team of more than 20 experienced professionals. The role reports directly to the team lead who is located in Toronto.

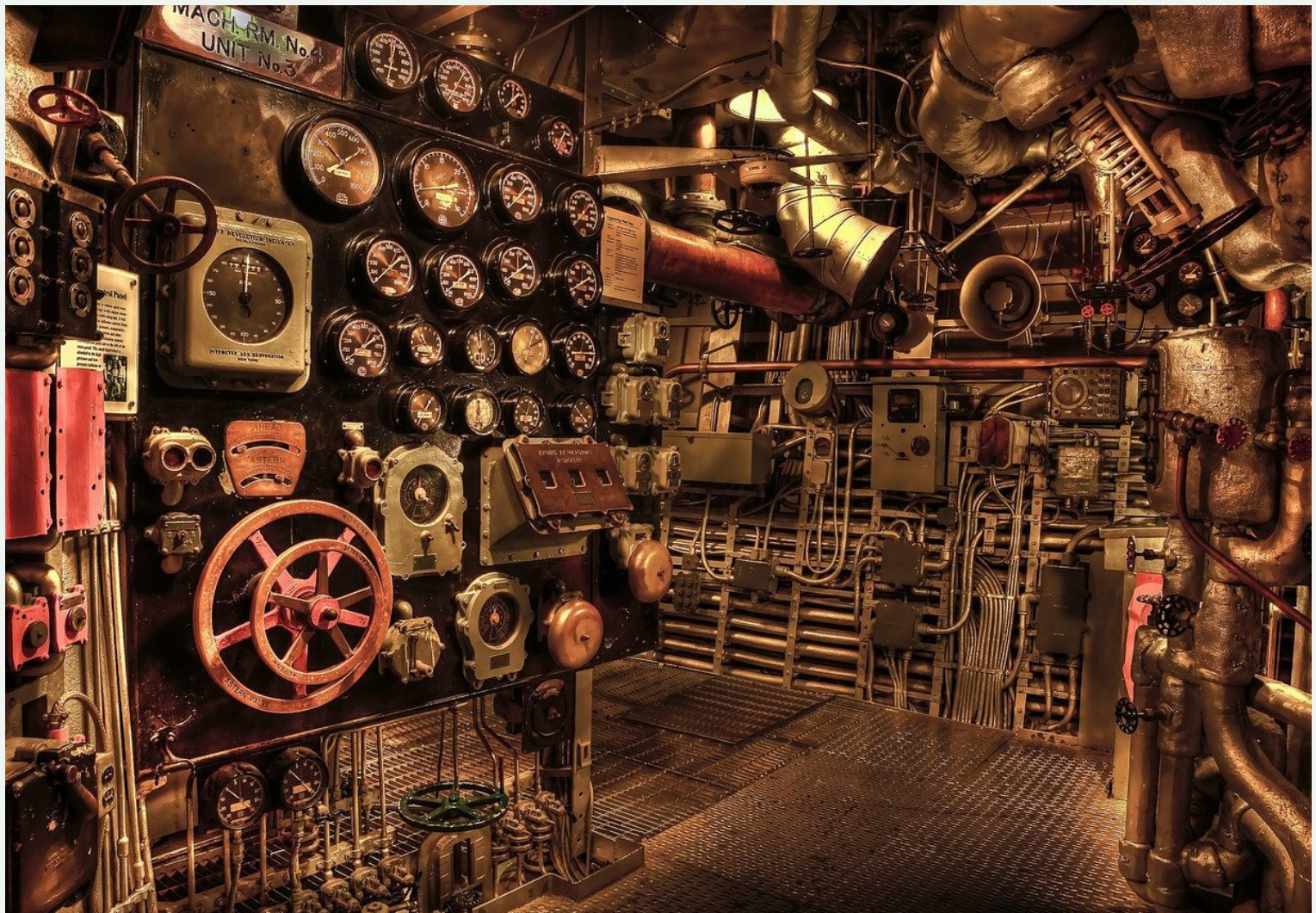

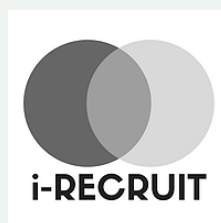
